



PRINCIPLES OF RISK ASSESSMENT

Aims:

This highly interactive course will examine the legal duty to assess and manage risk and the procedures for identifying, measuring and evaluating risk in the workplace.

Emphasis is placed on the completion of practical risk assessment exercises and by the end of the course delegates will understand the theory and practice of hazard identification and risk assessment.

Upon successful completion of the course, delegates will be awarded a Thomas, Carroll Management Services *'Principles of Risk Assessment'* training certificate.

Who should attend?

The course is suitable for anyone responsible for undertaking risk assessments or managing the risk assessment process.

Course duration:

A one day non-residential training workshop.

Course topics include:

- Understanding the difference between hazard and risk
- Calculating likelihood and severity
- Persons at risk
- Determining the adequacy of existing precautions and additional precautions required
- Developing safe working procedures
- Requirement for specific risk assessments
- Implementing a risk assessment programme
- Practical exercise
